During the semester, students will be evaluated based on their performance as follows: midterm examination for 16 points and intercultural profile of the selected city with small group presentation (for a total of 24 points). Students are expected to minimally 8 points at midterm exam and at least 12 points for an intercultural report. A total of 20 points are required. The final grade will be awarded as follows: A 91 to 100, B 81 to 90, C 71 to 80, D 61 to 70, E 51 to 60 points.

Learning outcomes:

Students are able to define basic concepts and describe selected theories in the field of intercultural communication with an emphasis on understanding their impact on interactions in everyday life in various communication contexts. Students are able to find, organize and interpret the latest information relevant to solving specific communication problems that arise in multicultural work teams. When communicating with a partner from a different cultural background (in terms of national culture), students are able to identify values that are important to their own culture and thus prevent conflicts. At the same time, they are able to find relevant information about cultural specifics of communication of members of the national culture of the communicating partner and in interaction with him / her identify basic cultural values and orientate in non-verbal communication of the partner. Students are able to propose ways to adequately address intercultural conflicts occurring in a multicultural workplace.

Brief outline of the course:

The course gives a comprehensive view of intercultural communication. First, it defines intercultural communication in general, approaching the barrier of intercultural communication and relevant models of cultural values. In the next part, cultural differences in various countries of Europe are discussed, focusing on specificities in verbal and non-verbal communication. Attention is also paid to intercultural communication in the work context, expatriots selection process, acculturative stress and intercultural communication competence. The last block focuses on migration, the process of acculturation and the network of intercultural cities.
