At each consultation meeting, specific tasks representing different statistical analysis methods used in psychological research will be solved. - Successful completion of the final exam. The final exam consists of solving statistical problems and defending the chosen procedures.

Learning outcomes:

The aim of the course is to acquire in depth theory and practical skills in the use of modern multivariate statistical methods.

After completing the course, the doctoral student has theoretical knowledge of advanced methods of multidimensional statistics. Based on the understanding of the solved scientific problem, he is able to apply theoretical knowledge to its solution. At the same time, the doctoral student will develop the ability of analytical-synthetic thinking in the processing and psychological interpretation of data. The student is able to critically evaluate and apply the findings obtained by appropriately selected statistical methods in solving a scientific problem.
