Conditions of continuous control and assessment: during the semester, the student is continuously controlled during the lectures, as long as the teaching is carried out in the classical form - face-to-face. If the teaching will be carried out differently - a distance form of teaching due to COVID-19, then the student will have assigned tasks for independent study of literature - philosophical texts, independent processing, (e.g. 2 sub-tasks - seminar papers) within the set deadline and preparation of the final seminar paper . The condition for registering for the exam is to pass a written test on the basic problems that are connected with the development of philosophical thinking from Thales to Nietzsche. Exam conditions: in the case of face-to-face teaching - only after successfully passing the final knowledge test, the student can take a written exam. In the case of distance learning - the student must complete a project - a final seminar paper - on which the student worked independently for the entire semester. During the semester, he handed in 2 partial outputs - seminar theses, where he demonstrates independent work with philosophical texts and tries to interpret them on his own while observing the bibliographic standard for seminar theses valid at KF FF UPJŠ in Košice.

Learning outcomes:

The student is familiar with the basic problems of the history of philosophy from Thales to Nietzsche. The discipline presents an overview of more specialized philosophical topics and works that influenced the development of disciplines such as psychology and social work. The student acquires the basic terminology from philosophy, and acquires knowledge from philosophy through the history of philosophy - by studying source texts from various periods of the history of philosophy in relation to the discipline of his field of study.
